Description:MAPK14(mitogen-activated protein kinase 14) is also named as SAPK2A,p38MAPK,CSBP1,RK,p38,EXIP,Mxi2,CSBP2,PRKM14,PRKM15,CSPB1,p38ALPHA and belongs to the MAP kinase subfamily. MAPK14-signaling is a central pathway for the integration of instructive signals in dendritic cells for T(H)17 differentiation and inflammation(PMID:22231518). It plays an important role in the regulation of hematopoietic stem cellself-renewal in vitro and inhibition of MAPK14 activation with a small molecule inhibitor may represent a novel approach to promote ex vivo expansion of hematopoietic stem cell(PMID:21198398). This protein has 4 isoforms produced by alternative splicing.

Antigen:Synthesized peptide derived from human p38 around the phosphorylation site of Tyr182

Form:

How to use:1.0 ml distilled water will be added to the product

Stability: Lyophilized product, 5 years at 2 – 8°C; Solution, 2 years at –20°C

Dilution:PBS (pH7.4) containing 1% BSA

Application:This antibody can be used for western blotting in concentration of 1?5?g/ml.

Specificity:Brain, heart, placenta, pancreas and skeletal muscle. Expressed to a lesser extent in lung, liver and kidney.
