Description: This gene encodes a nuclear protein, which is a tyrosine kinase belonging to the Ser/Thr family of protein kinases. This protein catalyzes the inhibitory tyrosine phosphorylation of CDC2/cyclin B kinase, and appears to coordinate the transition between DNA replication and mitosis by protecting the nucleus from cytoplasmically activated CDC2 kinase. WEE1 (WEE1 G2 Checkpoint Kinase) is a Protein Coding gene. Among its related pathways are PLK1 signaling events and Cell cycle Role of 14-3-3 proteins in cell cycle regulation. GO annotations related to this gene include transferase activity, transferring phosphorus-containing groups and protein tyrosine kinase activity. An important paralog of this gene is WEE2.

Antigen: Synthesized peptide derived from human Wee1 around the phosphorylation site of S642.
