Description:CHMP2A, also known as chromatin modifying protein 2A, belongs to the SNF7 family and it is component of the ESCRT III complex, which is required for multivesicular bodies (MVBs) formation and sorting of endosomal cargo proteins into MVBs.

Form:Liquid. In 20 mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH8.0) containing 0.1 M NaCl 1mM DTT, and 30% glycerol
