Description: Alpha crystallins are composed of two gene products; alpha-A and alpha-B, for acidic and basic, respectively. Alpha crystallins can be induced by heat shock and are members of the small heat shock protein(sHSP also known as the HSP20).

Form:Liquid. In 20 mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 7.5) containing 50 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA

Molecular Weight: 20.1kDa (175aa)
