Description:CST1 (Cystatin-SN) is a member of the type 2 salivary cystatin family found in a variety of fluids and secretions, including plasma, tears, and saliva. The cystatin superfamily encompasses proteins that contain multiple cystatin-like sequences.

Form:Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 2mM DTT, 10% glycerol, 100mM NaCl

Molecular Weight: 16.9kDa (145aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF
