Description:CST4 (Cystatin-S) belongs to the cystatin family. The cystatin superfamily encompasses proteins that contain multiple cystatin-like sequences. Some of the members are active cysteine protease inhibitors, while others have lost or perhaps never acquired this inhibitory activity.

Form:Liquid. In 20 mM Tris-HCl buffer, pH8.0, 10% glycerol, 1mM DTT, 50mM NaCl

Molecular Weight:16.8kDa (145aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF
