Description: The KHSRP gene encodes a multifunctional RNA-binding protein implicated in a variety of cellular processes, including transcription, alternative pre-mRNA splicing, and mRNA localization. KHSRP (KH-Type Splicing Regulatory Protein) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with KHSRP include Ataxia, Cerebellar, Cayman Type. Among its related pathways are CDK-mediated phosphorylation and removal of Cdc6 and Gene Expression. GO annotations related to this gene include nucleic acid binding and RNA binding. An important paralog of this gene is FUBP1.

Antigen:Synthesized peptide derived from the N-terminal region of human FBP2.

Form:

How to use:1.0 ml distilled water will be added to the product

Stability: Lyophilized product, 5 years at 2 – 8°C; Solution, 2 years at –20°C

Dilution: PBS (pH7.4) containing 1% BSA

Application: This antibody can be used for western blotting in concentration of 1?5?g/ml.

Specificity: Detected in neural and non-neural cell lines.
