Description:FARP2 (FERM, ARH/RhoGEF And Pleckstrin Domain Protein 2) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with FARP2 include Pseudohypoparathyroidism Ia and Aarskog-Scott Syndrome. Among its related pathways are Development Endothelin-1/EDNRA signaling and Focal Adhesion. GO annotations related to this gene include Rho guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor activity and Rac guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor activity. An important paralog of this gene is FARP1.
