Description:This gene encodes a sialoglycoprotein that is expressed on mature granulocytes and in many $B$ cells. The encoded protein is anchored via a glycosyl phosphatidylinositol (GPI) link to the cell surface. Modulates B-cell activation responses. Signaling could be triggered by the binding of a lectin-like ligand to the CD24 carbohydrates, and transduced by the release of second messengers derived from the GPI-anchor. Promotes AG-dependent proliferation of B-cells, and prevents their terminal differentiation into antibody-forming cells.

How to use: 1.0 ml distilled water will be added to the product

Stability: Lyophilized product, 5 years at $2-8^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$; Solution, 2 years at $-20^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$
Dilution:PBS (pH7.4) containing 1\% BSA
Application:This antibody can be used for western blotting in concentration of $1 ? 5 ? \mathrm{~g} / \mathrm{ml}$.
Specificity:B-cells. Expressed in a number of B-cell lines including P32/SH and Namalwa. Expressed in erythroleukemia cell and small cell lung carcinoma cell lines. Also expressed on the surface of T-cells.
