Description:PLD4 (Phospholipase D Family Member 4) is a Protein Coding gene. Among its related pathways are Role of phospholipids in phagocytosis and Innate Immune System. GO annotations related to this gene include phosphatidylinositol phospholipase C activity and N-acylphosphatidylethanolamine-specific phospholipase D activity. An important paralog of this gene is PLD3.
