Description:PGLS (6-Phosphogluconolactonase) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with PGLS include Lymphatic System Disease. Among its related pathways are Pentose phosphate pathway and Pentose Phosphate Pathway (Erythrocyte). GO annotations related to this gene include monosaccharide binding and 6-phosphogluconolactonase activity.

Antigen: Synthesized peptide derived from the C-terminal region of human PGLS

Dilution: PBS (pH7.4) containing 1% BSA
