Description: The protein encoded by this gene is a member of serine/threonine protein kinase family. This kinase preferentially activates other kinases involved in the MAP kinase signaling pathway. This kinase has been shown to directly phosphorylate and activate I κ B kinases, and thus plays a role in NF- κ B signaling pathway. This kinase has also been found to bind and activate protein kinase C-related kinase 2, which suggests its involvement in a regulated signaling process.

Stability: Lyophilized product, 5 years at 2 – 8°C; Solution, 2 years at –20°C
