Description: The tumor protein D52 (TPD52) family consists of three members, TPD52, TPD52L1 (D53), and TPD52L2 (D54). These small coiled-coil motif bearing proteins interact in hetero- and homomeric fashion. The TPD52 gene maps to chromosome 8q21, and due to amplification, shows frequent overexpression in prostate and breast carcinomas. TPD52 bound to annexin VI in a Ca(2+)-dependent manner, suggesting that these molecules may act in concert to regulate secretory processes in plasma cells.

Antigen: Synthetic peptide of human TPD52

Form:

How to use:1.0 ml distilled water will be added to the product

Stability: Lyophilized product, 5 years at 2 – 8°C; Solution, 2 years at –20°C

Dilution: PBS (pH7.4) containing 1% BSA

Application: This antibody can be used for western blotting in concentration of 1?5?g/ml.

Specificity:Isoform 2 is expressed in colon, breast, prostate, pancreas and kidney tumor cell lines. Isoform 2 is expressed at high levels in kidney, prostate, brain, small intestine and pancreas, at moderate levels in placenta and colon, at low levels in lung, liver and heart, and at very low levels in spleen, thymus, peripheral mononuclear blood cells, testis and ovary.

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
