Description:Ras-related protein Rab-21, also known as RAB21, is a member of the Ras superfamily of small GTPbinding proteins. Rab21 is integrin-associated protein and positive regulators of integrin traffic. This protein associate with the cytoplasmic domains of alpha-integrin chains and their expression influences the endo/exocytic traffic of integrins.
